# ***Cultural Adventure Walking Tour***

- ◆ **Tour is entirely at your own risk!**
- ◆ Good sturdy footwear is required. Trail may be wet in places & also please dress appropriately. It's easy to remove layers.
- ◆ Please arrive at 9:15 am for our 9:30 am 'sharp' departure time near the Joe Batt's Arm - South, fish plant where I will be waiting for you.
- ◆ Be prepared for a 2 1/2- 3 hour tour. If you arrive late, catch up if you can!
- ◆ Cost per person is \$ 20.00 with family & group rates available. Please call in advance for more details.
- ◆ 24- hr notice for all tours will be appreciated but not mandatory.
- ◆ Bookings can be done in advance by calling - 709. 658.7349. Please leave name & return phone #.
- ◆ Minimum 4 people per tour.
- ◆ Tour will be **Weather Permitting**. If it's really cold, raining, snowing or thunder & lightning, we simply won't be going!! :(
- ◆ Children **MUST** be accompanied by an adult.
- ◆ Daily Tours available. All tours will be in the morning unless otherwise planned in advance.
- ◆ Bring essentials such as: Sun Screen, Insect Repellent & Cool Shades. Please leave your Worries & Troubles behind as space is limited!!
- ◆ Anyone with allergies to the food mentioned below, please bring your own snacks.
- ◆ Please make a check -list prior to the tour so you will remember the important things such as: medications, camera, etc.

## **Some Highlights of the Tour**

Let's get to know each other & prepare for the walk. While we wait 15 minutes for any late arrivals I will tell you about the 'Fogo Process', which changed our lives in the mid 60's & the 'Black Box' that was found in 1942 which is said to contain Gold or the Frame of a man. Just so you know....we won't be digging it back up!

I'll take you Jane Tom's Root Cellar which is said to be HAUNTED. From there we will see Jane's Beach, Alfred Coffin's Vegetable Garden, Mickey Budgell's Beach, Fame Point, \*Cooper's Gaze & the \*Long Studio. Here we will off load our things and walk a little further while the snack is being prepared. While the kettle boils, I'll take you to Bottle Gulch- about 5 minutes further where I will point out the location of \*'Little Grebe's Cove', the \*Archeological 'Gross Water Eskimo Site' & finally, the location that will be the home of the bronzed \*'Great Auk Sculpture'.

Upon returning you will be treated to: mouth - watering *Home-Made Bread with Partridgeberry Jam & a good ol' mug of tea*. I'll also sing you original songs that I have written which will describe why it is that.... *"I Loves Where I'm From"*

- \* Long Studio- An Artist Studio overlooking the ocean. One of 4 to be built around Fogo Island.
- \* Gaze- A rock built wall which was and still is used for hunting sea birds. Also known as gauge. You can call it whatever you like!
- \* Gross Water Eskimo- evidence dating back 3000 years. An area which they used for hunting seals.
- \*The Great Auk Sculpture- Now extinct, large flightless seabird found 60 miles or so off this coast on the Funk Islands. Scientists agree that some were reported on the Grand banks in 1850. The Great Auk Sculpture is a gift from Artist, Todd Mc.Crain & the Lost Bird Project.

*Come let your sense of adventure soar! Dip your feet in the Salt Atlantic which someone once said- is good for Arthritis??  
Enjoy the relaxation & rejuvenation that is the great outdoors & search for treasures along our many rocky beaches.
